

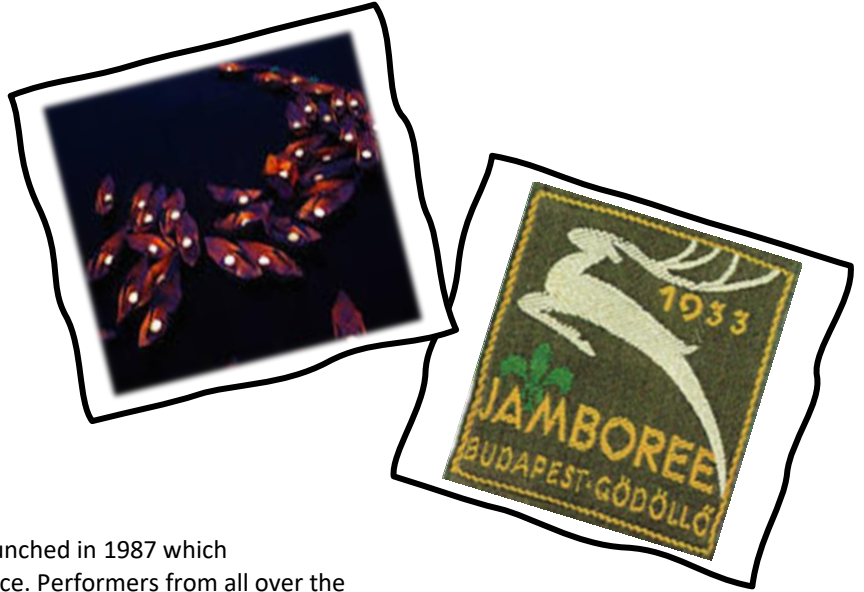
# WORLD BOX - 1933 - HUNGARY

(padding pool or large bucket)
- Internet Access



**Join in the Jamboree**

Each year Hungary puts on Summerfest, a festival launched in 1987 which aims to preserve the traditions of folk music and dance. Performers from all over the world now gather to showcase their traditions and celebrate each other's culture at the festival, which is held in cities of Ráckeve, Tököl and Százhalombatta between 12-22 August. The festival culminates in a Day of Candlelight which includes a lit boat parade along the River Danube.

## **Safety Notes:**

**Flame:** Make sure anyone handling naked flames is doing so safely. Check that the equipment and area are suitable and have plenty of ventilation. Have a safe way to extinguish the fire in an emergency.

**Scissors / Sharp Objects:** Supervise young people appropriately when they're using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

**Online Access:** Supervise young people when they're online and give them advice about staying safe.
