Theme – The Spirit Lives On

Activity – Canada Day Wands

What you need

- White and Red Card
- Straws or sticks
- Coloured Pens (Red is good)
- Pipe Cleaners
- Bells (optional)
- Glue

Join in the Jamboree

Canada in 1983, named 'The Spirit Lives On' to show how Scouting's spirit of international links could overcome the setback of cancelling the 1979 Jamboree.

Traditionally on Canada Day people make wands to wave.

Why not make a wand:

- Use this template to draw the outline of two leaves. Make them bigger so the two fill an A4 sheet of card.
- 2. Decorate with pens.
- 3. Stick together with a straw sandwiched between the two leaves to make the handle.
- 4. Use a pipe cleaner to decorate and attach bells if used.

Reflection:

People use flags or wands like the ones used on Canada Day to show their support at events. Can you design a wand to show your support for Scouting or Guiding?

Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.
