Cub Challenge 1

What you need:

- Access to the internet
- Mobile Phone (to use to film with)
- Paper
- Pen or Pencil



How to make it:

Campfires are a favourite part of any camp for every member of Scouting.

Think about fires at camp – they are not just to keep us warm...

Fire at camp helps everyone find a voice to tell stories, act out skits and sing songs.

1. Try to remember your favourite campfire story, skit or song.
2. If you can't remember one, have a look on the internet to see if you can find one.
3. Using a mobile phone to record your campfire story, skit or song to share with others.

Take it to the next level:

Why not make a series of Camp Fire Films to share with family and friends.
You could even fire them around a real or fake campfire to add atmosphere.

Safety Notes:

Online Access: Supervise young people when they're online and give them advice about staying safe.

Fire / Flame: Make sure anyone handling naked flames is doing so safely. Check that the equipment and area are suitable and have plenty of ventilation. Have a safe way to extinguish the fire in an emergency.
