# **Scout Challenge 1**

#### What you need:

- Access to the internet
- Mobile Phone (to use to film with)
- Paper
- Pen or Pencil



Our gardens and local parks are teeming with wildlife – and most of the time we do not notice what is all around us.

- 1. Take time to look for insects in your garden or local park.
- 2. Once you have found an insect that interests you, use a mobile phone to make a short film of the insect, taking great care not to injure it (or even touch it) in any way.
- 3. Use the internet to find out what the insect is, if you don't already know, and also find out about its lifecycle.
- 4. Share your film and what you have learned with others.
