Scout Challenge 1

What you need:

- Access to the internet
- Mobile Phone (to use to film with)
- Paper
- Pen or Pencil

How to make it:

Our gardens and local parks are teeming with wildlife – and most of the time we do not notice what is all around us.

1. Take time to look for insects in your garden or local park.
2. Once you have found an insect that interests you, use a mobile phone to make a short film of the insect, taking great care not to injure it (or even touch it) in any way.
3. Use the internet to find out what the insect is, if you don't already know, and also find out about its lifecycle.
4. Share your film and what you have learned with others.
