## CHALLENGE BOX MILK BOTTLE FAIRY LIGHT TRAIL

This activity is for Cubs but any section or leaders could take part too !

### Cub Milk Bottle Fairy Light Trail

#### What you need:

- Plastic Milk Containers
- Glo-Sticks
- Black Chunky Permanent Marker
- Water

#### How to do it:

Make these lanterns to light up your garden or why not set up a "Fairy Light Trail" for others to follow in your garden to lead to some treasure to share.

- 1. Wash some empty milk containers, making sure they are totally clean.
- 2. Using a chunky black marker pen, draw faces onto the containers.
- 3. Fill the bottles half full with clean water (to act as a weight) and add some stones too if the weather is windy.
- 4. To illuminate the bottle fairy light add a Glo-stick or two to each bottle and replace the lids.
- 5. Lay the bottles out in the daylight to form a trail or just to decorate the garden but don't activate and add the Glo-sticks until it is almost dark, so that you get the maximum life of the Glo-stick at dark.
