CRAFT BOX CHOCOLATE CRACKERS

This activity is for Beavers but any section or leaders could take part too !

Beaver Chocolate Crackers

What you need:

- 25g Milk Chocolate (broken into pieces)
- 10 Chocolate Mini Rolls
- 20 mini Reese's peanut butter cups
- Sprinkles of your choice to decorate
- General Kitchen Equipment

How to make it:

These little crackers make a great gift or tasty treat.

- 1. Melt the chocolate in a bowl above a simmering pan of water or in the microwave.
- 2. Dot tiny blobs of chocolate over the mini roll in lines or patterns.
- 3. Stick the sprinkles to the melted chocolate to decorate the "crackers".
- 4. Using more melted chocolate as glue; stick the mini cups onto the ends of the mini roll to form the cracker.

Safety Notes:

Food / Allergies: Check for allergies before you begin. Make sure you have suitable areas for storing and preparing food and avoid cross contamination of different foods. All activities must be safely managed.

Knives / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using knives. Store all sharp objects securely.

Hot Oven / Hotplates: Supervise young people appropriately when using an oven or hotplates for cooking.

Hot Water: This recipe uses very hot water – it is advised that this part is responsible for melting the chocolate.
