CRAFT BOX FOIL ART TREES

This activity is for Cubs but any section or leaders could take part too!

Cub Foil Art Trees

What you need:

- Cardboard (cereal packets or similar)
- Aluminium Foil (do not use non-stick)
- Sharpie Pens or Marker Pens
- Craft Materials (Pipe Cleaners, Stars, Gems etc.)
- Glue or Glue Stick
- Scissors



These trees can be as small or as big as you want, either way they are fun to make.

- 1. Cut out some basic tree shapes from the cardboard as shown in the picture.
- 2. Add some glue or glue stick to the cardboard and then cover the triangular part in foil, wrapping around to the back and sticking down with glue to secure.
- 3. Wrap the "trunk" of the tree with a pipe cleaner or tie with a ribbon and secure.
- 4. Decorate the foil with the sharpie pens or marker pens and add decorations made from whatever craft materials you have to hand the greater the variety the better.
- 5. Stick a star to the top of the tree this could be a home-made star or one from a craft pack.

Get more Crafty:

Why not make some small trees and use them as card toppers to make your own Christmas cards. Or you could make large ones as wall decorations.

Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors.

Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.
