Explorer Rock Wrapping Decorations

What you need:

- Large Round Stones
- Thin Cord or Leather
- Scissors
- Pointed Tool (Bradawl)
- Internet Access



How to make it:

Rock Wrapping is based on a Japanese basketry craft.
