What you need:

How to make it:

Your imagination is needed to make your own Christmas Tree, using anything that inspires you! Here are some ideas as a starter using pioneering poles (broom-handles), cake cases and even books...



Tools / Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.

Gardening and Nature: Wash your hands after the activity has finished and wear gloves if needed.
