Food Fun with a Festive Twist

Festive Mini Elf Houses

Ingredients:

- Biscuits (variety of different shapes and sizes)
- Cake Candy (variety of shapes and styles)
- Small Sweets
- Icing Sugar
- Water
- General Kitchen Equipment

Method:

These little houses can be as simple as you like or can be an architectural masterpiece – the choice is yours!

1. Plan the shape of the Elf house you want to make and look at the biscuits you have – consider the size, colour and even pattern on the biscuits and take time to think how the biscuits will fit together to make a house. You may need to use a knife to cut shapes into some of the biscuits so that they fit together better.
2. Mix icing sugar and water to make a thick icing to use as “glue” to join the biscuits together.
3. Use the icing to attach any candy or sweet decorations you want to add to the Elf house.

Here are some more designs to inspire:



Food / Allergies: Check for allergies before you begin. Make sure you have suitable areas for storing and preparing food and avoid cross contamination of different foods. All activities must be safely managed.

Knives / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using knives. Store all sharp objects securely.
