



# Picnic Box - Cornflake Bird Nests

This activity is for Beavers but any section or leaders could take part too!

## What you need:

- 225g plain chocolate, broken into pieces
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 50g butter
- 75g cornflakes
- 36 mini chocolate eggs
- Basic kitchen equipment



#### How to make it:

- 1. Line a 12-hole fairy cake tin with paper cases.
- 2. Melt the chocolate, golden syrup and butter in a bowl set over a saucepan of gently simmering water (do not let the base of the bowl touch the water).
- 3. Stir the mixture until smooth.
- 4. Remove the bowl from the heat and gently stir in the cornflakes until all of the cereal is coated in the chocolate.
- 5. Divide the mixture between the paper cases and press 3 chocolate eggs into the centre of each nest. Chill in the fridge for 1 hour, or until completely set.

# Get more Foody:

Try making your own eggs from marzipan.

Or maybe model some spring-time animals from ready-made icing.



## **Safety Notes:**

**Scissors / Sharp Objects:** Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors and knives. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

**Food / Allergies:** Check for allergies before you begin. Make sure you have suitable areas for storing and preparing food and avoid cross contamination of different foods. All activities must be safely managed.

**Hot Oven / Hotplates**: Supervise young people appropriately when using an oven or hotplates for cooking. **Hot Water**: This recipe uses very hot water, it is strongly advised that an adult is responsible for the boiling part.
