Challenge Box - Nature Frame Photos

This activity is for Explorers but any section or leaders could take part too!

What you need:

- Camera or smart phone
- Twigs or drift wood
- String
- Wood Glue
- Cardboard (optional)



How to make it:

In this activity you make a frame to take photos through.

- 1. Collect twigs and other natural items during your daily walk to design a frame.
- 2. Use string or glue to join the twigs etc. together to make a frame (you might choose to strengthen this by covering a cardboard cut-out template).
- 3. Leave to dry if using glue.
- 4. Go on a walk to the woods or a local park or into your garden and take some photographs through your frame, so it then becomes part of the picture!

The bigger Challenge:

What "frames" can you find in nature - explore the trees in your local park or woods too. Are there any holes to use to frame a picture, or think about using a group of trees as a frame?







Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.

Gardening and Nature: Wash your hands after the activity has finished and wear gloves if needed.
