



Challenge Box - Egg-box Animal Mask

This activity is for Scouts but any section or leaders could take part too !

What you need:

- Egg boxes
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- PVA Glue
- Paints and paint brushes
- Black permanent marker pen



How to make it:

Before you start, make sure you cover the work surface with an old cloth or newspapers.

1. Choose the animal to make into a mask or 3D picture and cut its nose out of an egg box.
2. Cut a picture base from a piece of cardboard and then colour the edge to represent a frame, and leave to dry. When dry add details with the marker pen to decorate the edge.
3. Paint the body of your animal onto the cardboard, within the "frame" and then paint the egg box 3D nose to match. Stick the nose onto the body of your animal and leave to dry.
4. Use the marker pen to add eyes and other features to your mask.

The bigger Challenge:

Make a gallery of egg box animal masks and create a feature wall in your bedroom.



Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.

Rubbish and Recyclina: All items should be clean and suitable for this activity.
