SCOUTS

Craft Box - Frozen Flowers



This activity is for Scouts but any section or leaders could take part too!

What you need:

- Flowers
- Bowl or bag
- Ice cube tray
- Water
- Jug
- A freezer or fridge freezer compartment
- Food colouring or glitter (optional)



How to make it:

The flowers take a few hours or preferably overnight to freeze.

- 1. Collect flowers, seeds and leaves from around the garden or local park using the bag or bowl.
- 2. Place the flowers into an ice cube tray (or if you don't have one you could use other very small containers that do not have any holes in).
- 3. Pour water over the flowers using the jug and gently press down with a finger tip to make sure the flower is submerged in the water fully.
- 4. (optional) Add extra decoration such as glitter or food colouring if you choose to.
- 5. Put in the freezer until completely solid.
- 6. Once set, pop the frozen flowers out and have a good look at the shapes and the colours of the flowers suspended in the ice.
